
EIGHT-YEAR-OLD GIRL LOSES FIGHT FOR LIFE

After a valiant fight for life, Lillie Mae Loftin, 8-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Loftin, of six miles west of Lancaster, passed away Friday, April 2, at the Palmale Hospital. She had been critically ill with pneumonia and whooping cough for several days and since March 29, had been kept alive by the use of the inhalator.

Lillie Mae was born in Locust Grove, Oklahoma, and had lived here with her family about two years. Three younger brothers, besides her parents, survive.

Funeral services were held Monday, April 5, at 2:00 with graveside services at the Lancaster Cemetery. Rev. Robert Roberts of Lancaster officiated.
