

Littlerock Child Dies from Scalding

LITTLEROCK — A 14-month-old Littlerock boy scalded himself to death by turning on the hot water tap while in the bathtub on Monday, Aug. 30.

The lad, Robert Charles Farley Jr. is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Farley Sr. of Ave. S-14 and 101st St. E.

Graveside services will be held in Lancaster Friday at 10 a.m. Father Martin Hiss of St. Mary's Church, Palmdale, will conduct the services.

The child was born on June 12, 1953, in the Lancaster Hospital and his parents have been residents of Littlerock since the spring of 1950.

Besides his parents, he leaves two brothers, Richard Claire and Rodney Clay, and a sister, Delores Ann. All four grandparents also survive the deceased, Mr. and Mrs. Lewis M. Farley of Jefferson, Iowa, and Mr. and Mrs. William Halligan, Glidden, Iowa.
