

Kennedy Services Conducted

Final rites for Wilbur Lee Kennedy, 54, who was stricken with a heart attack Nov. 18, while working at Edwards Air Force Base, were held Saturday at the Mumaw Funeral Home. Conducting the service LDS Bishop Ralph M. Clark.

Born April 24, 1904, in Temple, Okla., he was raised on a farm in Oklahoma where he remained until the war years when he moved with his family to California. He had been employed on dam construction projects and was working as an oiler for the Gallaway Construction Co. at the time of his death.

He moved to Antelope Valley in 1956. He and his wife, Mrs. Olive Lavena Kennedy, who survives, resided at the Cal-State Trailer Park, 45044 N. 48th Street East, Lancaster.
