

Mamie E. Clark Services Held

Funeral services for Mamie Elizabeth Clark, 67, of 127 W. Norberry St., Lancaster, were held at the Mumaw Funeral Home Monday at 2 p.m. Interment was in the family plot at the Lancaster Cemetery. Rev. Cecil Self of the Faith Bible Church conducted the services.

She was the mother of eight children, three deceased, and is survived by her husband, Andrew B. Clark, of the home address, one daughter, four sons, two brothers, 17 grandchildren, two great grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.

Survivors are, besides her husband, Josephine Graham, daughter, Salem, Oregon; Herbert K. Clark, son, Ontario, Oregon; James E. Clark, son, Chicago, Ill.; and, in Lancaster, two sons, Roscoe B. Clark and Eugene Bayles Clark; two brothers, Walter E. Scates and Charles E. Scates, Lancaster.

Mrs. Clark (Mamie Scates) came to Antelope Valley in 1906 and settled in Lancaster. She married Andrew B. Clark on Aug. 9, 1913 and they have lived here ever since. She was bus driver for Esperanza school district from 1923 to 1926 and at the same time raising her family and working with her husband and sons on their alfalfa ranch.

Since Clark's retirement in 1955 they have lived at the Norberry St. address. Together they have been known as Grandmother and Grandfather to many small children of their friends and neighbors.

She was born Jan. 21, 1895 and died Jan. 11, 1963 after a lingering illness.
