

Funeral Services for Electricuted Man Held at Lancaster

Funeral services at Lancaster were conducted by Rev. J. C. Wilson Thursday afternoon for Albert Henry Kuhr, who was electrocuted July 4 on his ranch near that city.

When found, Mr. Kuhr had been dead for several hours, and efforts made to revive him were unsuccessful. He came into contact with an electric wire while irrigating his ranch.

Mr. Kuhr was born in Wayne, Nebraska, on February 12, 1892. He was married in 1928 to Lela Findley who died in August 1922. He was re-married in June 1926 to Rachel Stein.

He is survived by one child Wyllis, his wife, and four brothers and sisters.
