

Josie Adele Sadler funeral rites

Funeral services for Josie Adele Sadler, 75, will be conducted at 11 a.m. tomorrow (Wednesday, Dec. 22) in the Mumaw Funeral Home, by the Rev. Donald Furrow of the Palmdale First Baptist Church. Interment will follow at Lancaster Cemetery.

A native of the Antelope Valley, born in Los Angeles Sept. 4, 1901, her family lived in the Del Sur area. She died Dec. 20, in Lancaster, following a heart attack.

For 20 years she was employed as a librarian, first at the Palmdale

Library, then at AV College. She was a member of the Royal Neighbors Eastern Star, the Daughters of the American Revolution, and of the Palmdale First Baptist Church.

Mrs. Sadler is survived by her husband, Lyle W. Sadler of the family home, whom she wed July 4, 1923, in Quartz Hill;
