
REDMAN LIBRARIAN IS FOUND DEAD AT RANCH

Mrs. Lydia M. Cissel, who was librarian at the Redman branch of the Los Angeles Public Library, was found dead in the corral at her ranch home last Wednesday, where she had gone to milk a cow. An autopsy was held Thursday morning and death was discovered to have been caused by hardening of the arteries. Funeral services were held Saturday morning at the Sacred Heart Church in Lancaster, with burial at the Lancaster cemetery. Mrs. Cissel is survived by her husband, Wm. L. Cissell. She was born in Cleveland, Ohio, May 14, 1883, and she and her husband had lived on their Redman ranch for 14 years. She was a member of Redman school board, and was active in affairs in that district.
