Jerry C. Young Passes Suddenly

PALMDALE—Jerry C. Young, 64, retired accountant now residing in Palmdale, passed away following a short illness on Tuesday, April 7.

Young was born in Savannah, Tenn., on October 26, 1888, and attended Henderson College and Texas Christian University.

He married Ula Rowan in 1915 in Memphis.

Before coming to California with his family in 1945 he engaged in both farming and banking. In this State he was a tax and general accountant in Whittier, Lancaster and Barstow. He recently retired and made plans to live in Palmdale to be near his family.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, April 10, at Mumaw's Funeral Home in Lancaster at 2 p.m. Rev. Morrison of the Church of Christ, Lancaster, will conduct the services. Young will be placed to final rest in Palmdale.
